"Bhutan+Nepal Higher Education for accomplishing the Sustainable Development Goals (B+NESDG)" is a capacity building project, which involves universities from Spain, Greece, Latvia, Nepal and Bhutan, co-funded by the Erasmus+ Project of the European Union. - 2. Statement of Purpose (SOP) (at least 500 words)
- 3. Updated CV
- 4. Certificates of achievement

The applicants will also have to submit a short video (60 seconds) on one of the SDGs.

# THE SELECTION OF THE STUDENTS WILL BE BASED ON

- 1. Academic Performance
- 2. English Proficiency
- 3. Statement of Purpose (Deadline: 26th August, 2022)
- 4. Short Video on one of the SDG (Deadline: 26th August, 2022)
- 5. Interview Session

All the applications will be ranked from the highest to the lowest score and the top scoring students will be selected by the selection committee. Results will be published on the Notice Board of School of Engineering and Website of Far Western University.
